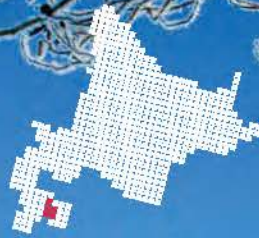

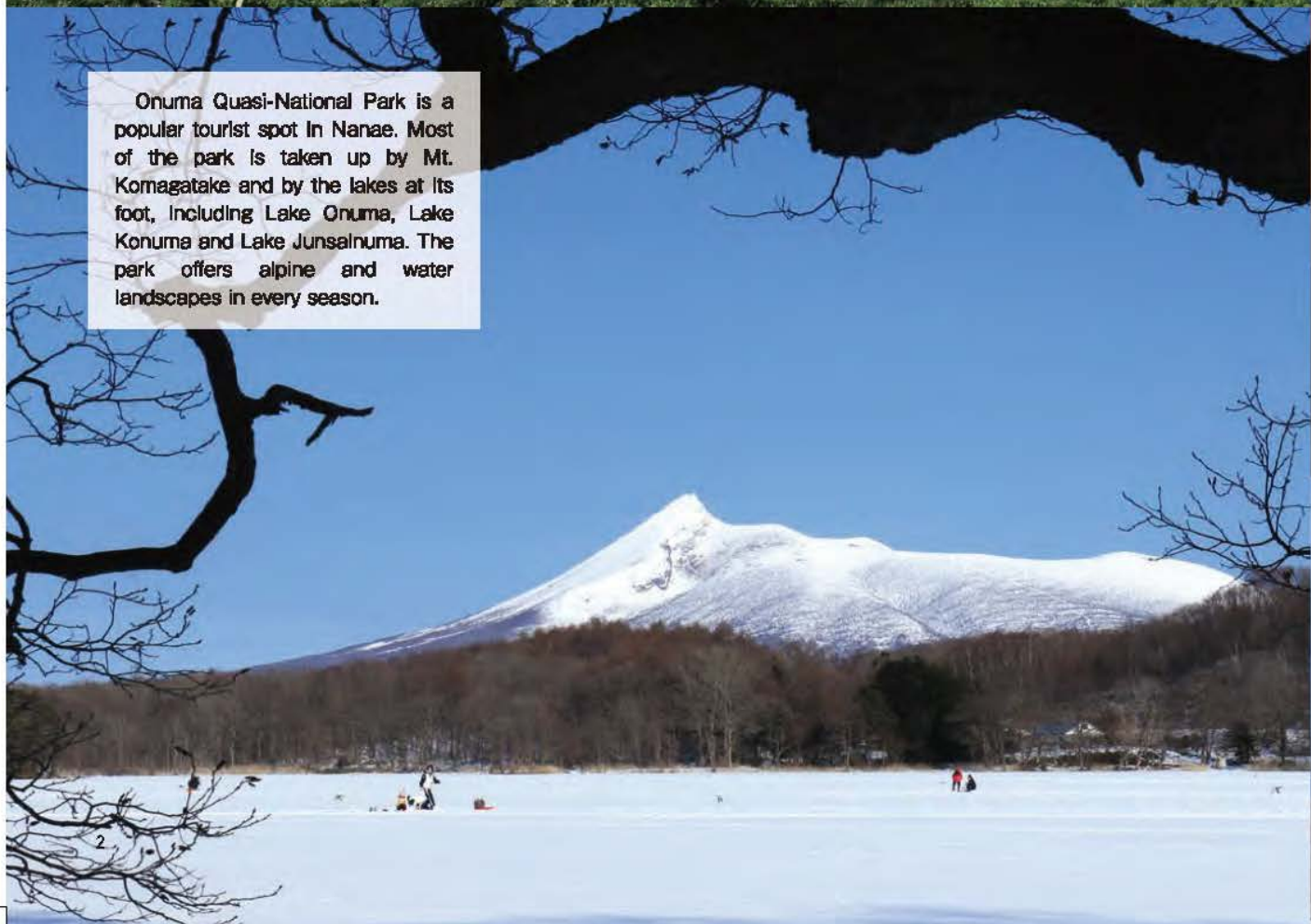

"The Nanae-kanen" agricultural station was established in Nanae in 1870 for experiments in American and European agriculture. Horace Capron, Edwin Dun and other foreign experts taught Western agricultural methods. Nanae was one of the first places in Japan to introduce Western agriculture. It's well-known as the first place where apples were grown. Fruits, vegetables, flowers and other crops are still grown.

Onuma Quasi-National Park is a popular tourist spot in Nanae. Most of the park is taken up by Mt. Komagatake and by the lakes at its foot, including Lake Onuma, Lake Konuma and Lake Junsalnuma. The park offers alpine and water landscapes in every season.

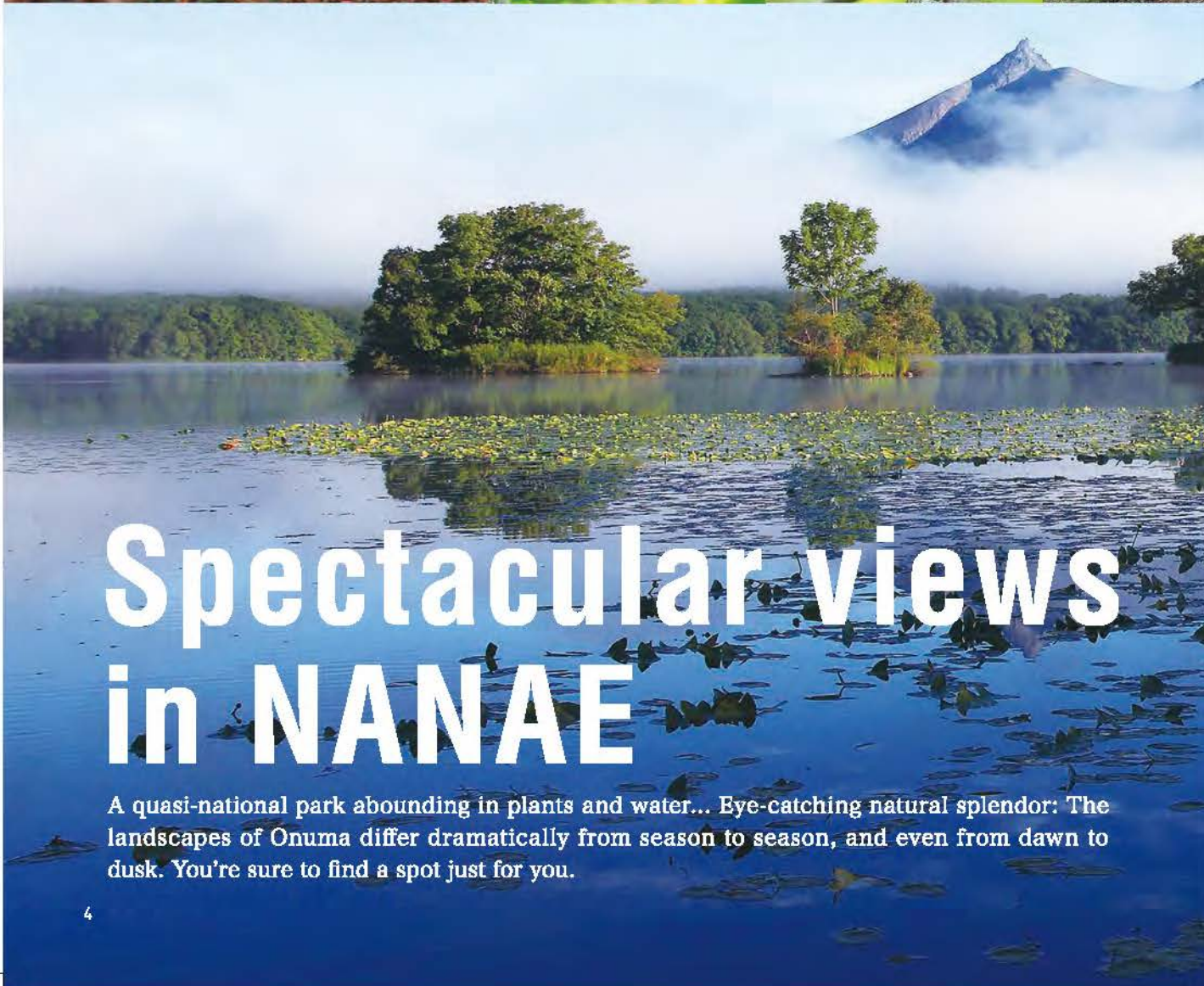

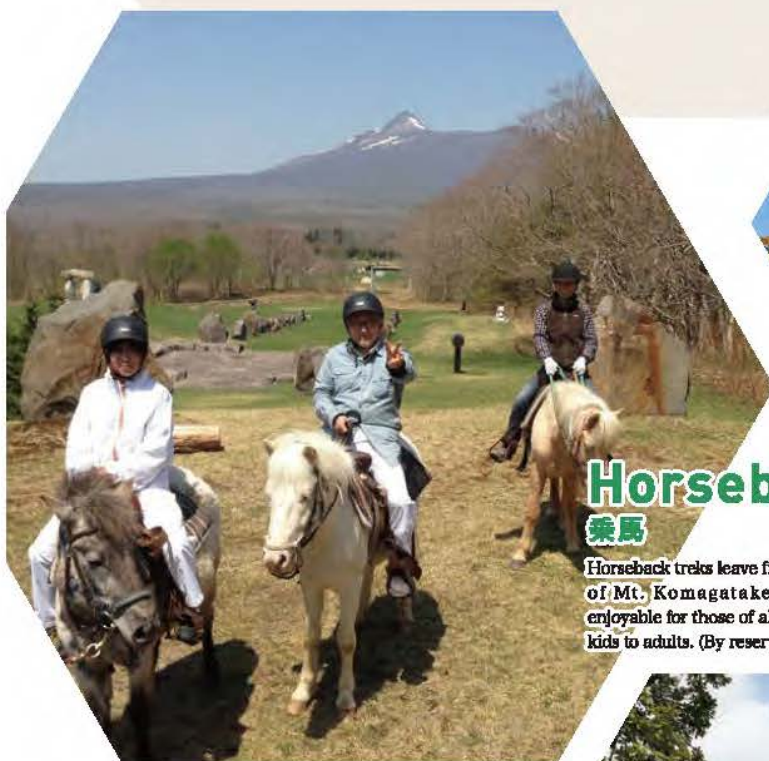

## Cycling サイクリング

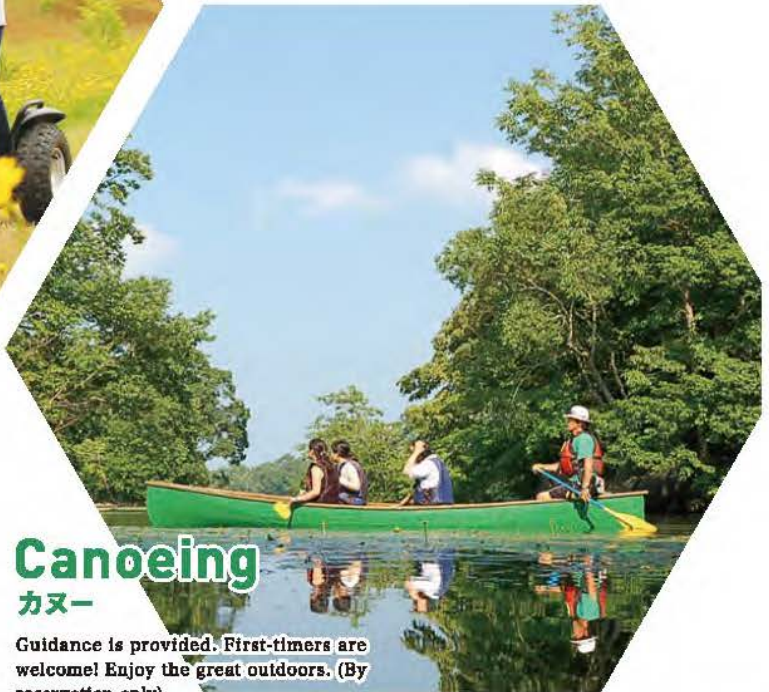
Rent a bicycle and ride around the lake. Feel the fresh breezes from Onuma. (The ride around Lake Onuma takes about 70 minutes.)
